
Reducing variation

The commons risks heading blindly toward "progress", misses tapping into the breadth of knowledge in the room and further marginalizing those who do not align.

Uncommons

A heterogenous grounds where negotiations take place toward a commons that is a continuous achievement; an event that is never final because it remembers that divergence is its constant starting point







Certain logics are dominant and some are more peripheral
